## CODE OF CONDUCT

Athena school, by virtue of the philosophy upon which it is founded, does not promote nor condone behaviour by students, staff, parents, nor visitors, which vilifies any other person, present or not, in any way.

Staff and students alike have the right to work in an environment where they are treated with courtesy and respect, without fear of violence or invalidation.

Guidelines to acceptable behaviour will be found in: Athena School Rules, How to Make Good Choices booklet, The Parent Information Pack and Staff Code of Conduct.

It is the responsibility of staff, students and parents to know, understand and follow the rules and guidelines set out in the Athena School Rules, both the Primary School and High School. In this way, they are aware of their responsibilities and rights and may exercise them.

It is the responsibility of teachers and school staff to know, understand and follow the code of conduct for staff and the code of conduct for students (How to Make Good Choices and the Athena School Rules) so that they may exercise their rights and responsibilities within the school environment.

### Senior Students

The Athena School does not operate a leadership program, such as a Prefect system. As the Athena School is based on egalitarianism, all senior students are expected to follow How to Make Good Choices precept No. 6, *Set a Good Example*, by knowing and following the school rules and all 21 precepts of How to Make Good Choices.
