



Study Tour Information Sheet

The Athena School offers a unique educational experience called a study tour for visiting overseas students or students from interstate for a period of a 4 weeks to a maximum of 12 weeks. We have different programs to suit your needs from beginner, intermediate and advanced.

Arrival Procedure

On your first day arrive by 8.30am for sign in and registration where you will be greeted by the Office Manager or one of our friendly school staff.

You will be given a tour of the school and introduced to your teacher and classmates. You will also meet the Quality Assurance Manager, who will go over school rules with you and help plan the schoolwork you will do while you are with us.

You will join in our regular classes from the very first day.

8.30am School gates open

8.58am School bell rings

9.00am Roll call and class starts

10.30am - 11.00am Morning Break/Recess. Bring a fruit or vegetable snack and a drink

12.15pm - 1.15pm Lunch Break. Bring food and a drink.

3.15pm School finishes for Primary school students

3.30pm for High School students.

4.00pm School gates lock.

Daily Attire

Study Tour students are not required to wear a full uniform. We do require that all study tour students in Primary School and High School purchase and wear our school's polo shirts during their study tour. During summer all students must have/wear *a sun hat that shades the face*, while in the school yard. A baseball style cap is fine. Once a week we have 'Sports Days' so students should wear sports shoes and clothes that are easy to move in.
